



Setup manual: E-mail client Thunderbird

Note: Outlook is the required email client for PSR users. Research staff are free to choose between Outlook and Thunder (the latter at their own risk). Linux users have complete freedom of choice.

1. Run Thunderbird.
2. If it's the first time a wizard will show up.
Otherwise, go to:

Tools > Account configuration... > Accounts operations -> [Add mail account...]

Then click to [Next] and fill the fields as following:

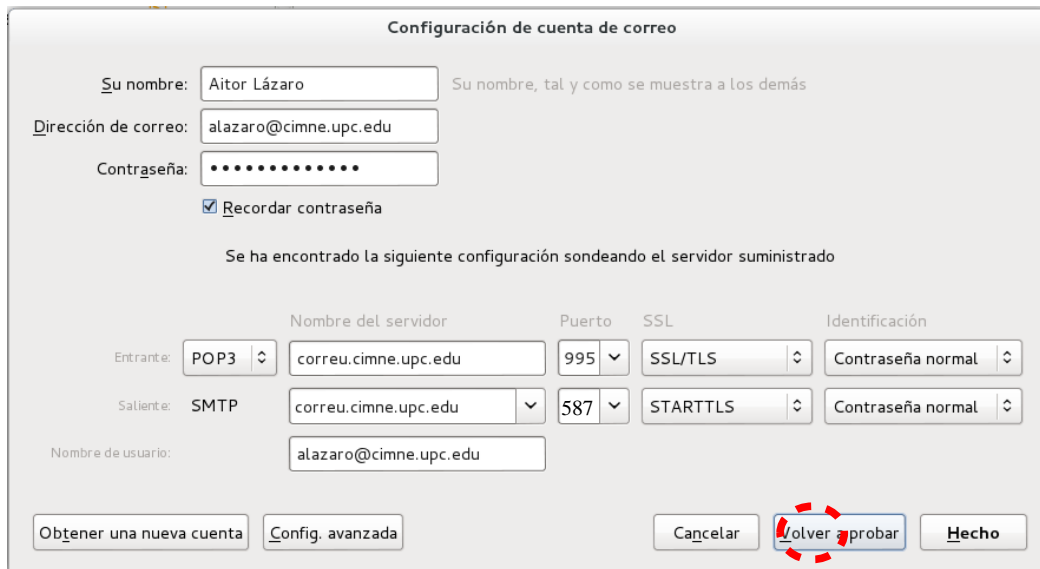
Clic on Manual Config. Then fill the fields as shown below.

4. When all the fields are set up, press [Try again], the next window should appear.

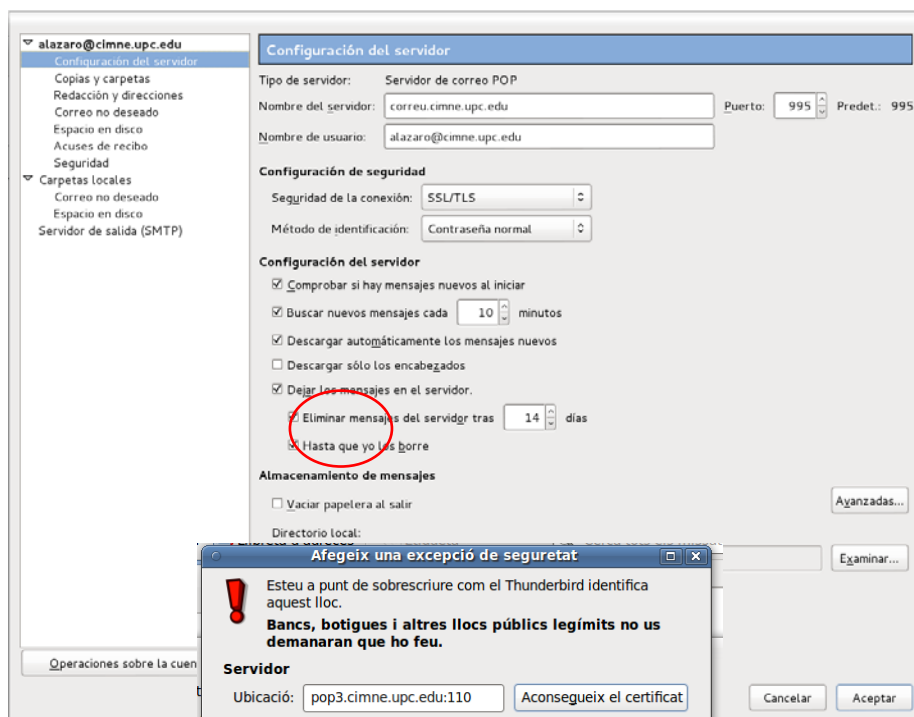

NOTE: To configure the client as IMAP you may choose the port number 993 instead of 995. IMAP is a protocol that leaves a copy of the emails on the server side, it is more useful when you are using more than one device at a time.
