

How to change security configuration of WiFi network

Recently we have changed the security mode for the access points of the wireless network RMEECIMNE

The reasons of this change are:

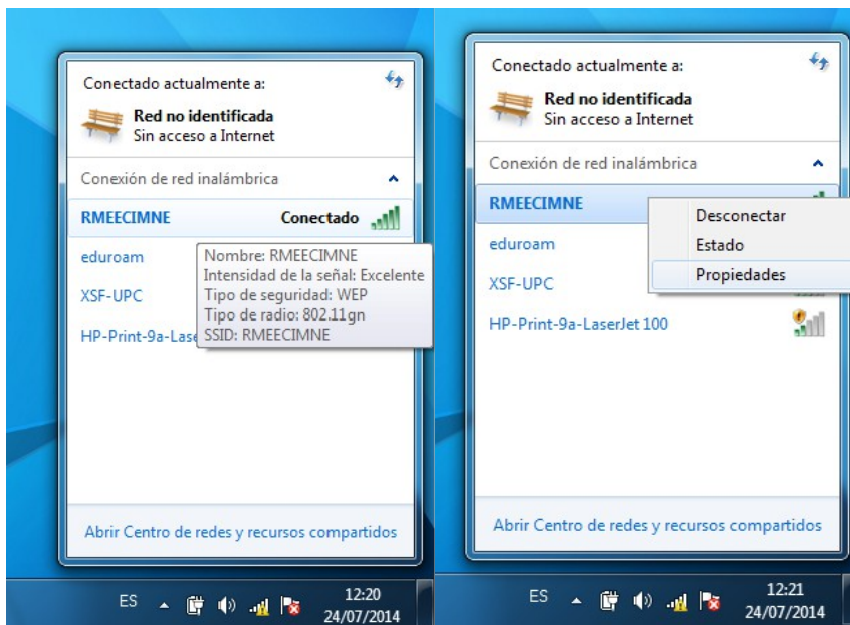
- WEP Security is, now, easy to decipher.
- The last Windows systems (Windows 7, since the last updates, and Windows 8 desktop and mobile) are not compatibles with WEP security networks.

In the next pages we will explain how to change the security mode in computers which were connected before the change. If you connect for first time to the network you don't need follow this steps.

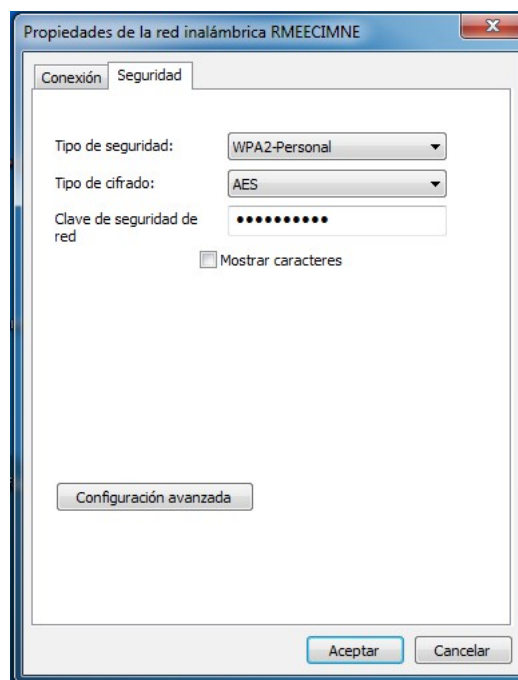
The password has not been changed.

Windows 7

On the menu bar click at the WiFi network icon. Do right click at the RMEECIMNE network and select “Property” option.



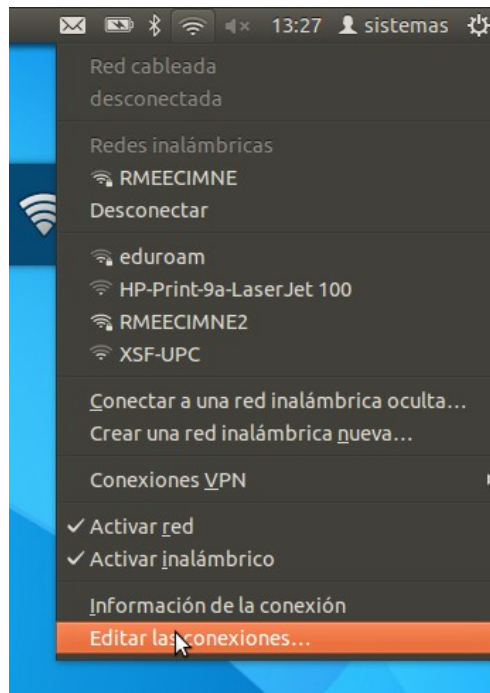
In the appearing window go to “Security” and configure it like the image:



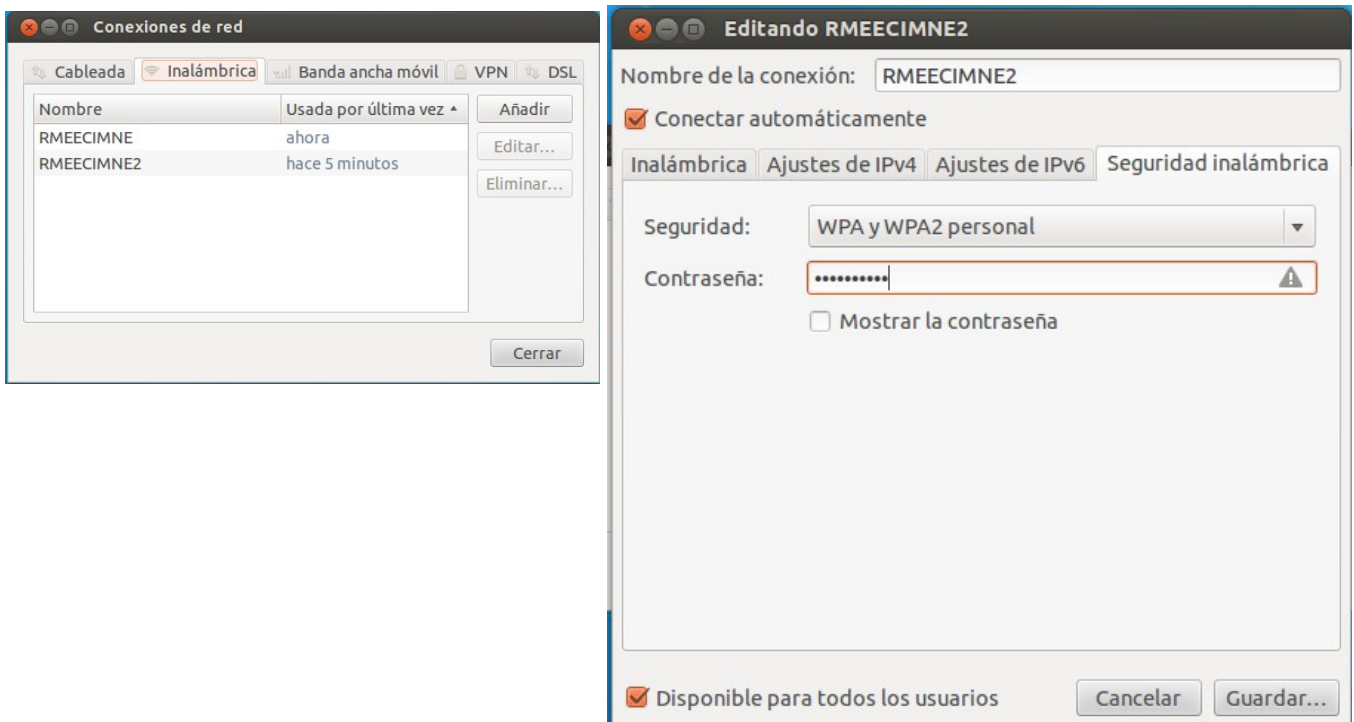
Save the configuration and automatically the system will reconnect with the network.

GNU/Linux Ubuntu

On the menu bar click at network icon. Choose the last option, “Edit connections”, of the list.



In the next window go to “Wireless” and select RMEECIMNE network (in the example is RMEECIMNE2) and click on “Edit”. In the appearing window go to “Wireless Security” and configure it like the second image.



Save the configuration and automatically the system will reconnect with the network.
